Systems change grant: Typically US \$10-25 million of flexible support over 6 years, accompanied by non-financial support to strengthen organizations

From our earliest days, Co-Impact has sought to advance gender equality.

Building on this experience, we developed a second fund - the Gender Fund - to help accelerate the global movement for gender equality to substantial scale.

Evidence-based: Through a rigorous vetting process, we find powerful ideas that have been proven to work for tens of thousands of people, and provide the size and nature of support needed to drive results for millions.
